How to be a brilliant SENCO

It could be argued that the SENCO role is not only one of the most important roles in school, but it is also one of the most demanding in terms of its breadth and depth.

This session will explore practical strategies to enable you to balance the demands of the day-to-day role, whilst considering how you can strategically develop inclusive provision within your school.

With a strong focus on SENCO wellbeing, the session will look at how to develop your systems and support networks to enable you to shape and develop your role as a leader within your school.

As Senior Lecturer in Education: SEN at Bath Spa University, Dr Curran oversees the Postgraduate Certificate in SENCO/National Award for SENCO and the MA in Inclusive Education. Prior to this role, Helen worked as a specialist advisory teacher for SEN for Wiltshire Council. She has also worked as an independent SEN/dyslexia consultant, and as a class teacher, SENCO and Assistant Headteacher. SEN is Helen's primary area of research and she is particularly interested in the role of the SENCO and how SEN policy is enacted in schools. She led the National SENCO Workload Survey, in conjunction with the NEU and nasen, and recently published a book with Routledge, 'How to be a brilliant SENCO: Practical strategies for developing and leading inclusive provision'.
